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INTRODUCTION

The University of Ruhuna was established on 1st September 1978, as Ruhuna University College by a Special Presidential Decree. At the beginning there were only three Faculties; Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Agriculture and Faculty of Science. At present the University of Ruhuna has 10 faculties: Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Fisheries and Marine Sciences & Technology, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Faculty of Management and Finance, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Science and Faculty of Technology.

The central administration unit of the University is located at the Wellamadama University complex. The ten faculties are located at different locations: Faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, Fisheries and Marine Sciences & Technology, Management and Finance, Science and Graduate Studies are located at the main University premises at Wellamadama, Matara while Faculties of Agriculture, Engineering, Technology, Allied Health Sciences and Medicine are located in Mapalana (Kamburupitiya), Hapugala (Galle), Kamburupitiya and Karapitiya (Galle), respectively.

The University offers Bachelor, Master and PhD degrees in their respective disciplines. In addition Diploma and Certificate courses are conducted in various disciplines.

Table 1 shows the student population of each Faculty in year 2024.

This tracer study of the graduates of the University of Ruhuna in 2024 was conducted in parallel with the 31st General Convocation of the University of Ruhuna which held in December, 2024. The aim of the study is to examine the employability of the graduates of the University of Ruhuna and to examine the student's satisfaction of the services offered by the University of Ruhuna. As such, the survey investigated the employability of the graduates of different programmes and faculties and student's satisfaction in teaching learning environment, various services, units and departments at the University of Ruhuna. It is expected that the results of this survey would be useful for academic and administrators both at policy and implementation levels.

SCOPE AND THE METHODOLOGY OF THE SURVEY

The survey endeavored to examine the employability of the graduates at the 31st General Convocation held in the year 2024. After a series of discussions at the Senate Standing Committee on Quality Assurance, a structured questionnaire was prepared. The questionnaire was administered via online to collect data. The graduates were requested to fill the questionnaire prior to the general convocation. All the instructions to complete the survey questionnaire were given in advance to the graduates. Of the total of 2100 graduates who were to be graduated in the General Convocation, 2070 graduates participated the survey, resulting in a 99% response rate .

Table 2 shows the composition of the graduates from each Faculty and the number of respondents of the survey.

Descriptive statistics were used in the analysis. General perspective of the graduate's employability is addressed at the beginning followed by a degree wise comparison.

SECTION ONE:

EMPLOYABILITY OF THE UNDERGRADUATES OF UNIVERSITY OF RUHUNA

The overall employability of the University of Ruhuna graduates at 30th General Convocation, is presented under five areas;

- Demographics of the Graduates
- English Language Proficiency and Computer Literacy
- Extra – Curricular Activities Involved
- Teaching Quality of the Program
- Employability of the Graduates

DEMOGRAPHICS OF THE GRADUATES

Gender, ethnicity, faculty studied, type of the degree obtained, medium of instructions of the degree, class obtained and residential area of the graduates are described in this section.

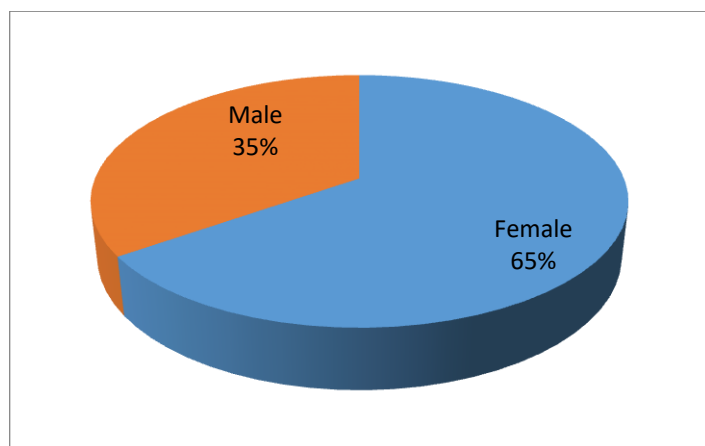


Figure 1: Gender Distribution of the Graduates

As shown in Table 3 and Figure 1, majority are female graduates and only 34.7% are males.

As given in Table 4, an overwhelming majority (93.5%) of the undergraduates are Sinhalese while there are 3.2% of Tamil and 3 % of Muslim undergraduates.

Table 5 shows the gender wise number of graduates from each Faculty. Majority of the graduates (20.5%) are from Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, followed by Faculty of Management and Finance with 19.3% graduates.

According to Table 6, 64.5% of the graduates have secured at least a second class lower division in their respective programmes while 35.5% secured only a general pass.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY OF THE GRADUATES

Table 8 shows how the English language proficiency, as rated by the graduates themselves in three aspects: oral, written and reading. Eightpercent of the graduates admitted that their English oral proficiency is either “weak” or “very weak”. Above 97% of the graduates claimed that their proficiency in reading and writing is either “very good” or “good”.

COMPUTER LITERACY OF THE GRADUATES

Computer literacy of the graduates was checked under five aspects: Word,spread sheet and presentation, Database management system, Networking, Web designing and working with data analysis software.

Except for few graduates (0.7%) almost all the graduates have fair or above level of competency in word, spread sheet and presentation skills. Above 78% of the graduates have “fair or above” competency levels in database management systems, networking and working with data analysis software except web designing. Twenty percent of the graduates had no capability of web designing.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES INVOLVEMENTS

Table 10 shows how the graduates involvements in extra-curricular activities. Accordingly, only 18% of graduates involved in obtaining professional qualifications along with their academic activities. Involvement in activities such as; sports, voluntary engagement, student societies and aesthetic & cultural activities is considerably higher. However, it was noted that nearly 16% of the graduates admitted that they did not involve in any of the extra activities. Interestingly, around 15% of the graduates had engaged in part time employments while following their academic programmes and none of the graduates have engaged in full time employments.

PERCEPTION ON TEACHING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Graduates response to a series of statements regarding the teaching learning environment they experience are presented in the Table 11. Majority of graduates were happy about the library facilities (90%), lecturers/instructors (89%), LMS/Open education tools (90%), tutorials (89%). Around 85% happy about the teaching methods while only, 75% were happy about the lab facilities, 82% were happy about the practical knowledge and 77% happy about the practical trainings. Eighty

four percent agreed about the adequacy of the research skills. Seventy eight percent agreed with the statement “ there was a student centered teaching learning programme at the university”. Twenty percent disagreed with the statement “ degree program didn’t promote memorizing lecture notes”.

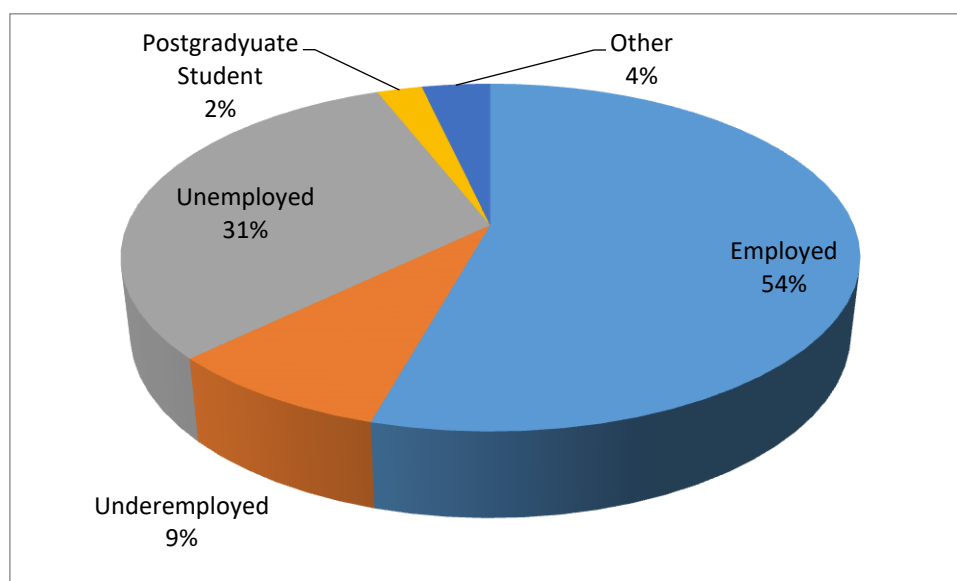


Figure 2: Current Employment Status of the Graduates

As shown in the above Table 13 and Figure 2, 54% of the graduates were employed while 31% of the graduates were unemployed. The percentage of graduates who claimed themselves as under employed was 9. Only 2% of graduates engaged in postgraduate studies.

Table 14 shows the employment type of the graduates. Almost 57% of the graduates were employed either permanently or temporary at the time of the graduation.

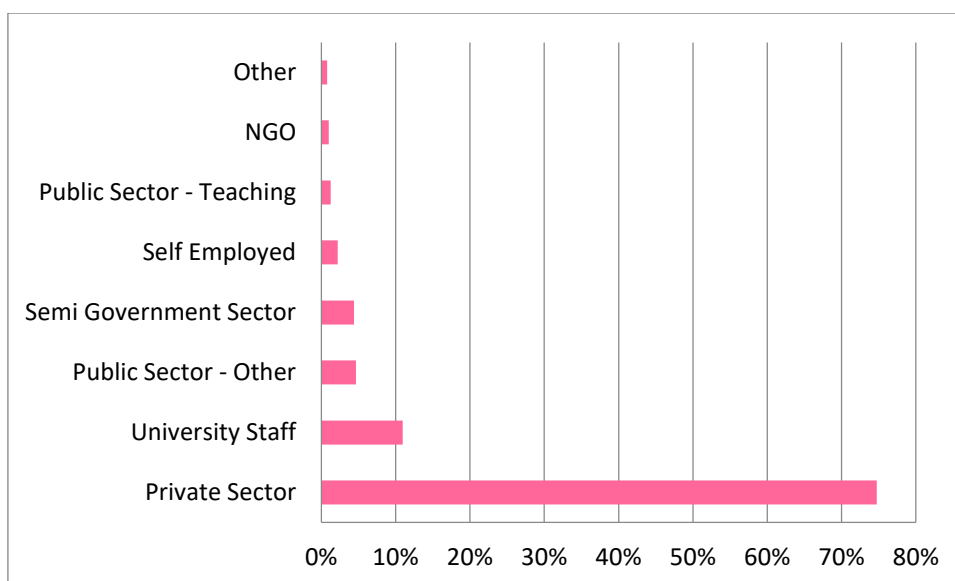


Figure 3: Sector of Employment of the Graduates

Table 15 and Figure 3 illustrate in which sectors graduates are employed. Around 75% of the employed graduates are working in the private sector. Sixteen of them are government teachers and 11% are working as university staff. Only 28 graduates were self-employed.

As given in the Table 16, 24% of the employed graduates are in middle management or management trainee positions and 7.6% are in administrative positions. Very few are in the economic and financial positions. Around 10% are in IT positions.

Employing 22% and 15% of the graduates in manufacturing sector and education sector were the main employers (Table 17). 12% are in the health care sector while 11% in IT field. 6% of them are doing banking and finance related jobs. Very few work in telecommunication sector.

According to the Table 18, nearly 82% of the employed graduates were at least somewhat satisfy with their current employment. Around 7% of the graduates were either very unsatisfied or unsatisfied about their current employment.

Salary expectation of the graduates is given in the Table 20. Around 90% of the graduates expect above Rs. 50,000.00 salary.

Table 21 shows the relevance of the study field to the current employment of the graduates. 53% of the graduates agreed that the job is very much related to their field of study. Around 12% of the graduates claimed that their employments are not related to their field of study.

Employment position by the class of the degree is given in the Table 28. Majority of the first class degree holders were employed as lecturer/instructor positions(31%).

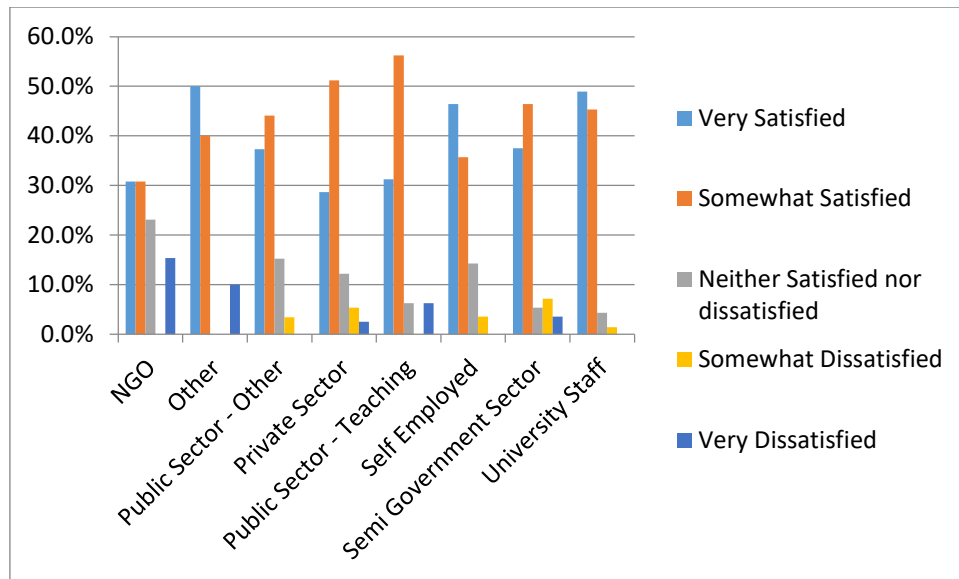


Figure 4: Satisfaction with the Sector Employed

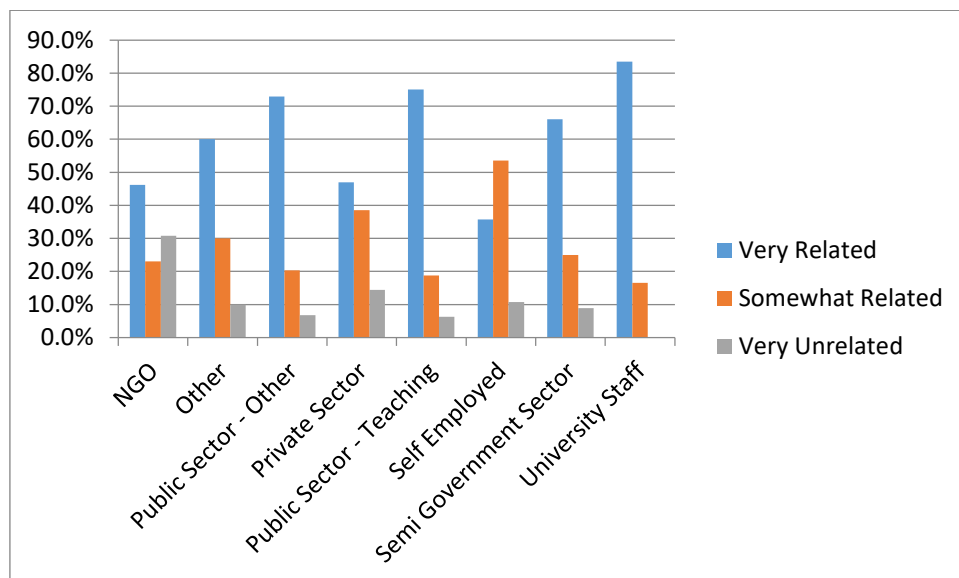


Figure 5: How Far the Job Relate to the Field of Study

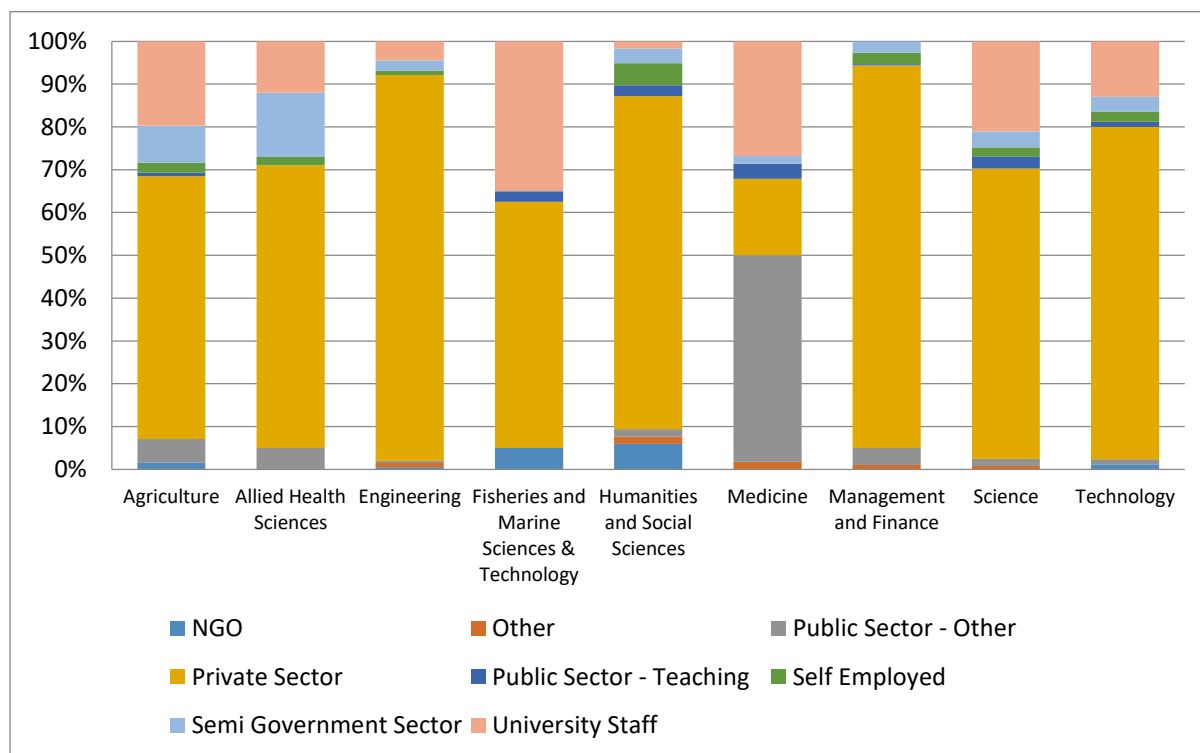


Figure 6: Faculty wise Employed Sector

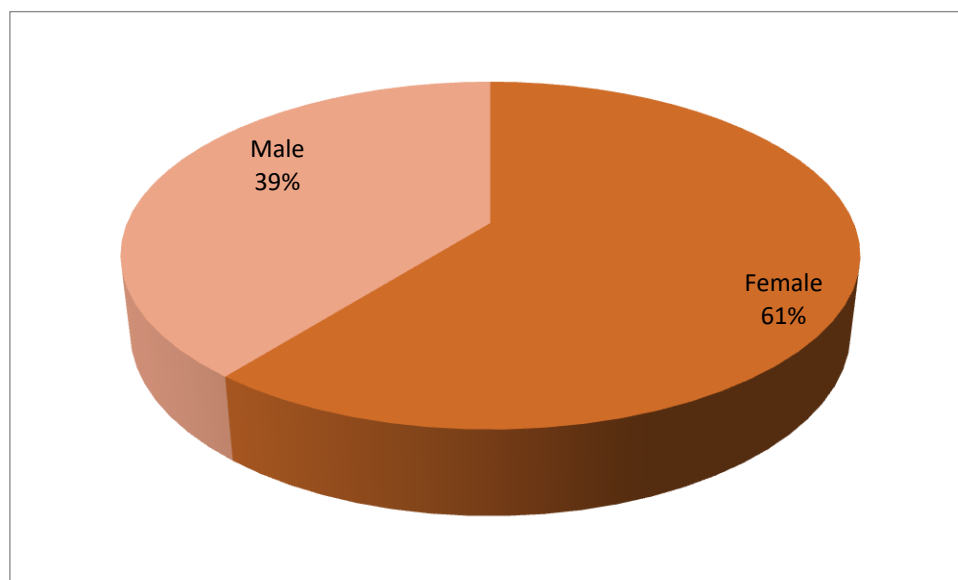


Figure 7: Gender Distribution of Post Graduates

As in the above figure 61% of the graduates are females and 39% are males.

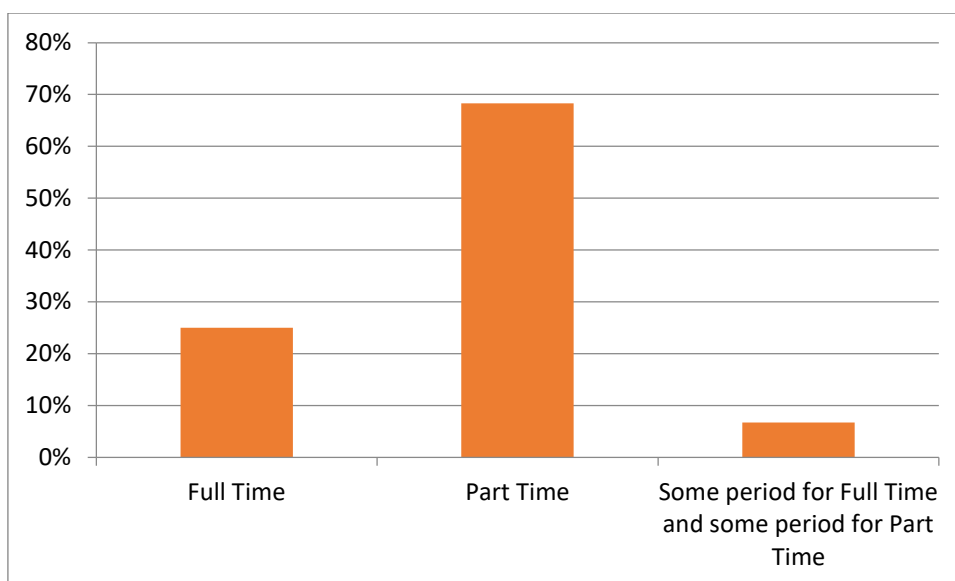


Figure 8: Nature of the Degree

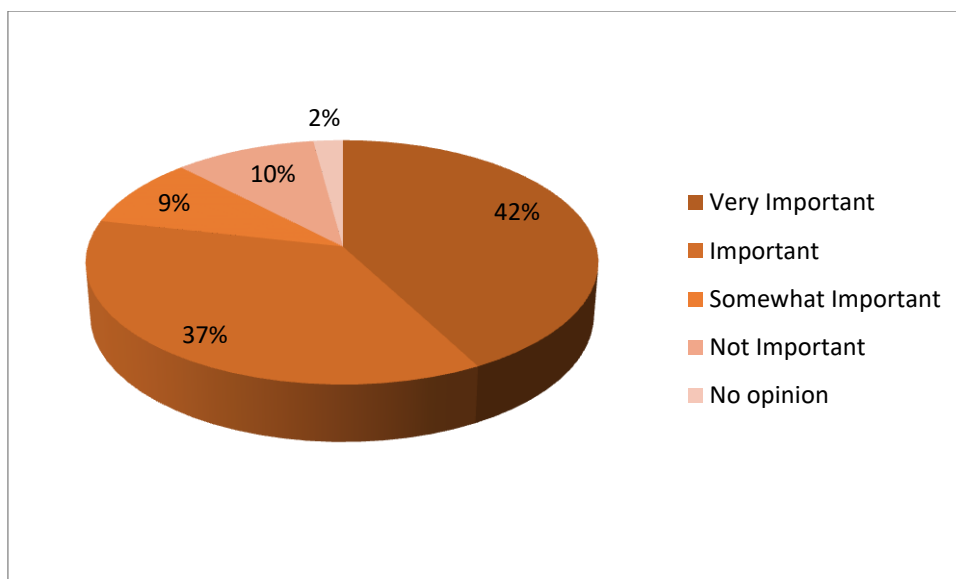
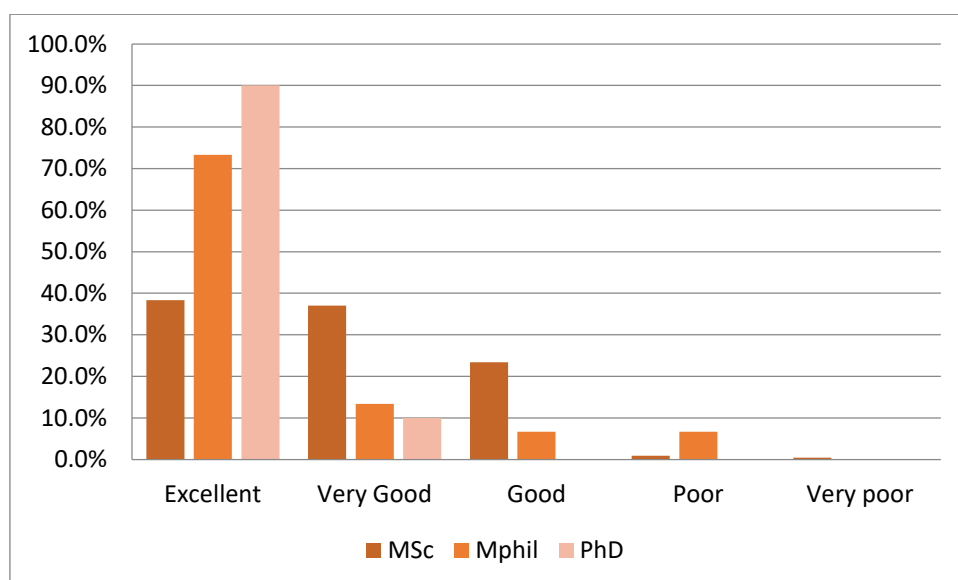


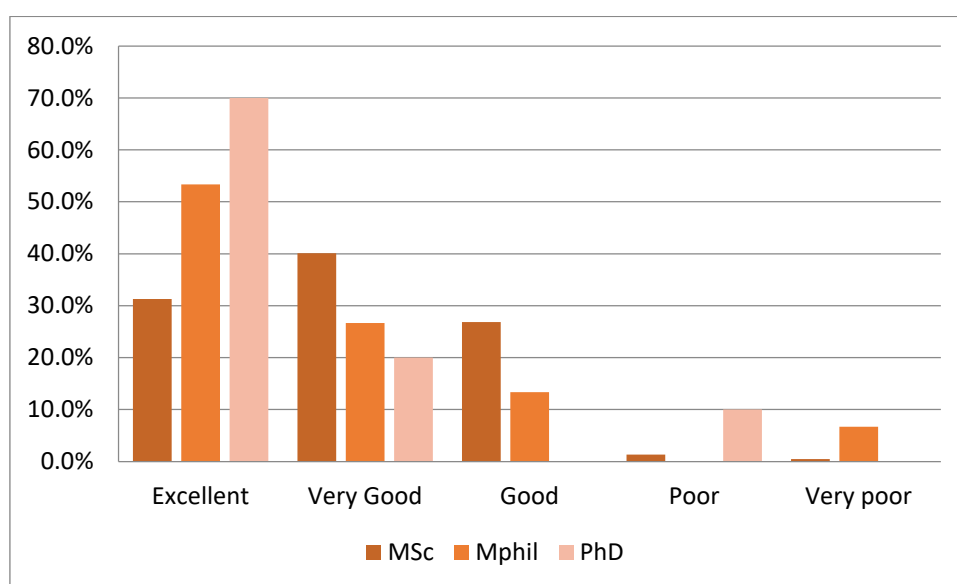
Figure 9: Importance of getting a post graduate qualification

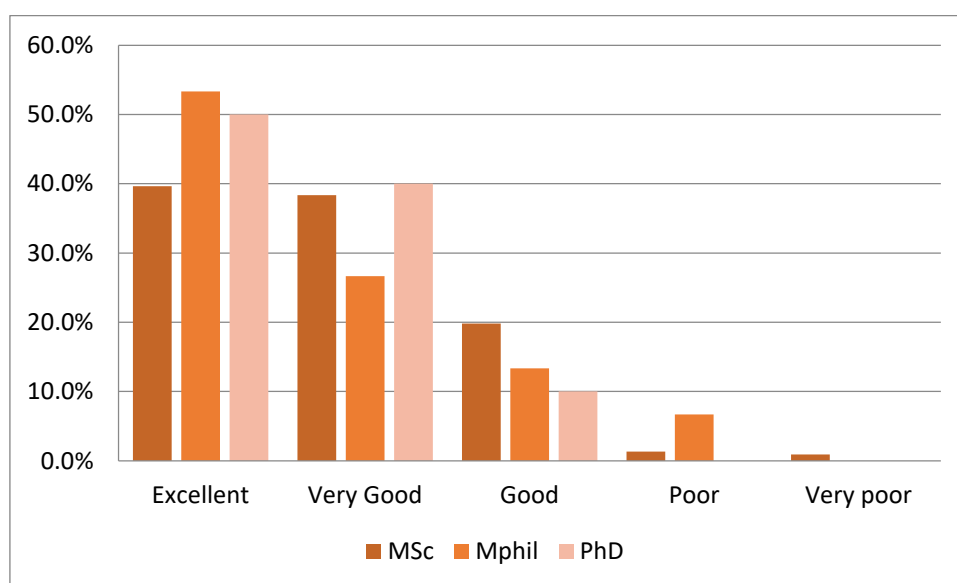
- Quality of Supervision – Principal Supervisor
